The Group recorded a revenue of RM50.89 million and profit before tax of RM2.25 million for the current quarter compared to revenue of RM45.95 million and profit before tax of RM3.31 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 December 2018, representing increase in revenue of 10.76% and decrease in profit before tax of 31.95%. The higher revenue in the current quarter was mainly due to the growth in apparel categories, while the profit before tax was lower mainly due to the increase in staff costs.

B3. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

Economic uncertainties and increasing cost were the main concerns of our retailing business, we have found it challenging to pass on these rising costs to our customers due to intense competition and cautious consumer spending.

We will keep implementing measures to address the challenges facing by the Group. However, we believe with the several measures and incentives being introduced by the government will improve the disposable income of households, and thus consumer spending. These measures will positively impact the Group's retailing business in the next financial year.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, we expect the Group continue to deliver satisfactory performance in the next financial year.
